



Frequently Asked Questions

If I hostess a table do I have to buy all 10 seats?

No, the hostess decorates the table, provides the dinnerware and favors for all 10 seats, and creates a warm and welcoming atmosphere at her table.

Who supplies the "favors" for the tables?

The hostess provides the favors for the 9 guests at her table.

How much should I pay for the favors?

Keeping the gift under \$5 each is a good rule of thumb. Ideas could be: an ornament, a small booklet, a Christmas mug with cocoa inside.

Will there be chair covers? What color will they be?

White chair covers will be provided.

As a table hostess am I responsible for plates, silverware, napkins, and glass ware?

We encourage you to provide all the components of your table that you can. If you are missing some of the required items, we will work with you. Don't forget to ask that relative, friend or neighbor who has lots of 'stuff'. Please mention your needs to your Hostess Coordinators and we will help.

Last year my table was far away. How can I get a table closer to the stage?

All tables are sold on a first come, first served basis. There is not a bad seat in the house.

I want my table to be next to my friend's table - can we do that?

We cannot guarantee table placement. Two things to keep in mind: tables are sold in order, on a first come, first served basis. If you both buy your table at the same time, it is likely you will be placed next to each other.

Can my friend who doesn't go to GCC hostess a table?

Yes! If she is not able to be at Grace on a Sunday morning to buy her table, then you may buy it on her behalf. You may bring a check she has written, or she may reimburse you for the cost. She must commit to attending the Hostess Workshop on Nov 20th @ 7pm.
