1. Last Sunday, we learned about what Heaven will be like. Over the past week, were you able to spend time learning about and imagining Heaven? What did you learn?
2. Read Colossians 3:1-4. What does this passage say about our identity as Christians?
3. In light of being raised with Christ and being hidden with Him, what does this passage say about how we should now live?
4. Read Matthew 6:19-21. Jesus mentions, "where your treasure is, there your heart will be also." What do you think you currently treasure the most? Are there certain things you treasure that draw your heart farther away from God? What about things that draw you closer to God?
5. Kevin Maurice often mentioned living with Heaven in mind. What sort of qualities do you think characterize a Heavenly-minded person?
6. Over this next week, with a desire to become like Christ in all of life, what are some steps you can take to live in light of our home in Heaven?
