1)	Last week, we learned through the life of Solomon that humility is the way toward wisdom and obedience. Over the past week, how have you sought to fight against pride, and cultivate a heart of humility?
2)	Read John 15:1-8. In this teaching from Jesus, who takes on the role of the Vine, the Vinedresser, and the Branches? What is the purpose of each of these roles?
3)	In this passage, Jesus teaches his disciples about bearing fruit. In the Christian life, what does it mean to bear fruit? See Galatians 5:22 for examples of Godly fruit.
4)	Read John 15:1-8 a second time. What is the purpose of Jesus' teaching here? What message is He trying to convey to His disciples?
5)	The primary subject of this passage is abiding in Christ. What does it mean to abide in Christ? What does abiding in Christ look like in your daily walk with Him?
6)	This week, how can you become like Christ in all of life by abiding in God? What is a step you can take to abide with Jesus?
