3)	The book of Esther demonstrates the sovereignty of God. How should God's sovereign plan and power to accomplish His plan effect our daily walk with God?
4)	Read Esther 4. What is Esther and Mordecai's response to the plot to kill the Jews?
5)	Esther was placed in her specific circumstances "for such a time as this" (4:14). Thinking about your current circumstances, what opportunities has God placed in your life to courageously obey Him?
6)	This week, how can you become like Christ in all of life by surrendering to the sovereignty of God?
