- 1. Last week, we learned about the return period led by Ezra, and how in the midst of difficulties, the church can be a group living in love, obedience, and service. How did you seek to live out these three characteristics over the past week?
- 2. Read Nehemiah 1:4-11. What does Nehemiah pray for in this passage?
- 3. What does Nehemiah's prayer in 1:4-11 reveal to us about the state of his heart toward God?
- 4. Throughout the book, Nehemiah displays courage, humility, and perseverance. How would you define these qualities, and why are they valuable in the Kingdom of God?
- 5. Nehemiah reveals to us that courage, humility, and perseverance are valuable assets of a Christian's heart. This week, how can you become more like Christ by living out one of these qualities?
