THE KING'S CORONATION Matthew 3:1-17

- 1. Last week, we learned that Jesus the Messiah is the King of all Kings through learning about His lineage. Over the past week, how did you choose to submit to Christ and give Him the glory He is worthy of?
- 2. Read Matthew 3:1-12. What commands does John the Baptist give to his audiences? Knowing Jesus was soon to come, why do you think these were the commands John gave?
- 3. As Jesus the King is about to arrive, John the Baptist tells people to repent. Repentance is to have a change of heart. In your walk with God, what do you need to repent of?
- 4. Read Matthew 3:13-17. What is unique about the baptism of Jesus? What do you think is the purpose of this moment?
- 5. Jesus' baptism serves as His coronation ceremony as King. How should Jesus' Kingship affect your daily walk with God?
- 6. John the Baptist would go on to later say, "He must increase, but I must decrease." This week, how can you walk in the power of the Spirit, where Christ alone is exalted?
