

The following questions correspond the How Do We Behave sermon from Sunday, November 10. To catch up on the entire Q Series visit grace360.org/q-series.

1. At Grace, we believe that the Bible is the clearest expression of Truth available for us to pursue. 2 Timothy 3:16-17 says that "all scripture is inspired and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training." How often do you open your bible and dig into the Scriptures during the week?
2. Read all of 2 Timothy 3:16-17 as a group. There is a distinction between viewing this book as authoritative and actually submitting yourself to it as the authority. What does the text mean here when it uses the word "inspired"?
3. Through submission, after finding out the meaning of a passage we change the way we think about an issue, we alter our feelings towards a situation or do something we wouldn't otherwise do. What are some ways you have submitted to scripture, even when you didn't want to?
4. Submission means: Doing something even though we may not want to do it. Look at 2 Timothy 3:16-17 again. These verses mention that scripture is "useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training." As a group talk about these actions and what they mean.
5. Grace will teach the Bible and that it transforms our lives, not merely to reading it to check a box or have more information. What are some situations in which you have used Scripture for teaching, rebuking, correcting or training?
6. The Word of God is the means the Father has chosen for the Spirit to transform men and women for His glory. Pick one of the following and refuse to quit before it is finished:
 - If you do not have a devotional time, use Proverbs. Read the chapter that corresponds to the day of the month; then, pick one of the verses that stands out to you and memorize it. Ask God to help you understand and obey it that day.
 - Read the entire book of James or Philippians each day for a month.
 - Commit to memory an entire chapter of one of your favorite books of the Bible by the end of the year. If you are looking for a suggestion, consider Romans 5 or Romans 8.
