Genesis 1-2

1. We talked at the start of the year about spending more time in God's Word. Some of you may even be following the plan with Grace to read through the entire Bible in 2020. Share with each other how that is going and what you are learning.
2. Read Genesis 1:26-31 together. When God created man, how was it different from the rest of creation?
3. People were created in God's image—different in kind, not in degree from the rest of creation. He gave us purpose. You can know your purpose by knowing Scripture and by knowing your gifts. How has God gifted you, and how can you give God glory with the way He has made you?
4. Look at Genesis 1 again. Where do you see God ascribing value to His creation?
5. In what do you root your identity? You are infinitely, objectively valuable to God—no matter who you are, what you've done or how you're living now. He sacrificed His own Son for you. How does knowing your value shape who you are, how you live and how you see other people?
6. If our goal is to become like Christ in all of life, how do you plan to pursue this and how can you encourage each other this week?
