

- 1) Last week, we learned about restoring justice, specifically within the context of racism. Over the past week, how have you chosen to educate yourself and take action on this topic?
  
- 2) Read 1 Kings 3:3-15. What does this passage reveal about Solomon's character (at the beginning of his reign)? In response to God's prompting, what does Solomon ask for?
  
- 3) Solomon humbly asks God for wisdom to lead his people in a righteous manner. In your daily context of life, how can you lead others around in you in a righteous way?
  
- 4) Today we learned that the end of Solomon's life was characterized by pride. How would you define pride? How can pride cause destruction in your relationship with God and with others?
  
- 5) In his concluding prayer, Pastor Matt quoted Philippians 2:1-11. What does this passage tell us about the importance of humility? How did Jesus provide for us the ultimate model of humility in this passage?
  
- 6) Matt Cassidy concluded by saying, "Humility is the way of wisdom and obedience." This week, how can you become like Christ in all of life by fighting against pride, and seeking a heart of humility?
