

Sermon Questions – July 26, 2020

1. Last week, we learned about the return period led by Ezra, and how in the midst of difficulties, the church can be a group living in love, obedience, and service. How did you seek to live out these three characteristics over the past week?
2. Read Nehemiah 1:4-11. What does Nehemiah pray for in this passage?
3. What does Nehemiah's prayer in 1:4-11 reveal to us about the state of his heart toward God?
4. Throughout the book, Nehemiah displays courage, humility, and perseverance. How would you define these qualities, and why are they valuable in the Kingdom of God?
5. Nehemiah reveals to us that courage, humility, and perseverance are valuable assets of a Christian's heart. This week, how can you become more like Christ by living out one of these qualities?
