

Sermon Questions – August 9, 2020

JUST WAIT!

1. Last week, we discussed relational discipleship and how we can THRIVE during this season. Over the past few months, what is one area of your life where you have been able to THRIVE?
2. Read Malachi 4:1-4. What does Malachi say is awaiting for the people of God? What command does he give to them while they are in this season of waiting?
3. Malachi tells the people of God to “Remember the law of my servant Moses, the decrees and laws I gave him at Horeb for all Israel.” We too, are called to remember the laws of God. How can you remember God’s commandments this week?
4. During the 400 years of silence, God was still sovereignly at work. A universal language was put in place, roads were being built, and hope was instilled in the people of Israel. With hindsight, have you experienced moments of God at work even during times when you may not realize? Share these with the group.
5. In this midst of COVID-19, many of us are in a season of waiting and uncertainty. In the midst of this, what are you hoping God will accomplish?
6. Pastor Robert gave us four ways we can align our hearts with God’s during this season:
 - 1) Decide to Trust
 - 2) Work on our Hearts
 - 3) Obey
 - 4) Celebrate
