1) Last week we learned about the beauty and potential of the Church, Christ's Bride. Over the past week, how did you choose to love and serve the Church?

2) Read Acts 6:1-15. How does this passage describe Stephen?

3) In Acts, the author Luke mentions Stephen being full of faith, the Holy Spirit, grace, and power. If someone were writing a description about your character, what do you think it would say? What are your hopes for what a description of you might say?

4) Pastor Matt taught us that a key component of following Christ (specifically seen in Stephen's story) is having a Godly perspective. Have you had a moment that in hindsight, God gave you a different perspective on? Share this with the group.

5) Read Acts 1:1-9. In verse 8, Jesus tells the apostles they will be His witnesses to the ends of the earth. What does it mean to be a witness for Christ? Who is someone in your life that you can be witness for Christ to?

6) Today we learned about the boldness of Stephen and the potential the Church has when we are bold in our faith. This week, as you seek to become like Christ in all of life, what is something bold you can do for the sake of the gospel?
