(Acts 10)

1) Last week, we learned about the boldness of Stephen in the book of Acts. Over the past week, what was something bold you decided to do for the sake of the gospel?

2) Take a few minutes to read Acts chapter 10. What amazing work is God accomplishing through this moment? What does God show Peter through this story?

3) "The ministry of the gospel was more important than Peter's own comfort" – Pastor Matt. It is easy for us to often succumb to our comforts, as opposed to surrendering completely to Christ. What typically holds you back from sharing the love of Christ with others and boldly proclaiming the gospel?

4) Today we learned about God often choosing to do powerful things in our lives through prayer. Take a moment to think about your prayer life. What do you typically pray for? What are some ways you have seen God at work (either in your own life or others') through prayer?

5) In Acts 10 we see the miraculous works of God on display, where He "does the heavy lifting." As a group, take a moment to share some of the great works God has done in your life.

6) As you head into this Thanksgiving week, how can you become like Christ in all of life and courageously proclaim the gospel? Brainstorm some ideas as a group. Could this involve: Praying for someone? Hosting an outdoor gathering of neighbors? Making a meal for a friend? Inviting a co-worker to your Life Group?
