(Revelation 19:11-16)

1) Last week, we learned about the miraculous works of God seen in the story of Peter's vision in Acts 10, and how this compels Christians to live boldly for Christ. Over the past week, how did you seek to courageously proclaim the gospel to those around you?

2) Read 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18. What does this passage say about what Christ will do for His Church in the future? What does this passage say about the future for Believers?

3) Reflect on the words "we will always be with the Lord" (1 Thes. 4:17). How can this truth affect your daily life/walk with God?

4) Read Revelation 19:11-16. How does John describe the Second Coming of Christ in these verses? What does this passage reveal about what Christ will do in His second coming?

5) The book of Revelation tells us that Jesus will be victorious, execute perfect justice, and He will rule forever. Imagine living each day with this truth in mind. What would your life look like? How would you choose to live and what characteristics would describe you?

6) After mentioning what is held in the future for the Church in 1 Thessalonians 4, Paul writes, "Therefore, encourage one another with these words." Take a moment this week to reflect on the passage we studied today, and seek encouragement from the Lord. Finally, who can you encourage this week with the hope found in Christ?
