



## FAQs

### **When are the students leaving for Retreat?**

Check-In will take place on Friday, January 21 in the Grace Courtyard at **5:30pm**. Students will turn in any medications at check-in. Please complete the Grace Online Waiver & the Camp Tejas waiver before coming to check-in. Both can be found at [grace360.org/youth](http://grace360.org/youth).

### **When are the students getting back from Retreat?**

Approximately **3pm** on Sunday, January 23.

### **Are cell phones or electronic devices allowed at Retreat?**

NO. Cell phones/computers/electronic devices are NOT allowed at Retreat. We want our students to have a restful, immersive weekend and believe this is best done without devices.

### **What are the Covid precautions?**

Masks are OPTIONAL. Buses and Bunkhouses will be at no more than 2/3 capacity to allow for moderate spacing in these areas.

### **Will there be swimming?**

No. The water is too cold and Camp Tejas has put away their water activities.

### **What are the steps for student discipline?**

If a student breaks a camp rule or behaves disrespectfully, a verbal warning will be given. If the student continues to break rules, he or she will meet with a few adults to address the situation more thoroughly. If problems persist, parents will be called to collaborate on a solution and possibly come pick the student up.

### **Will my son or daughter need extra spending money?**

Short answer – No. However, Camp Tejas does have a gift shop that will be open. Snacks, drinks, souvenirs, etc. are available for purchase.



## Packing List

- Clothes for weekend (FUN Ski Attire encouraged!)
- Bible (with student's name in it)
